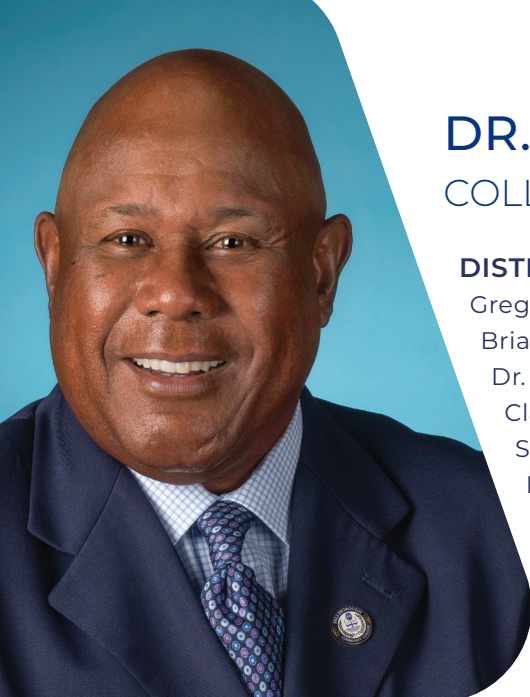

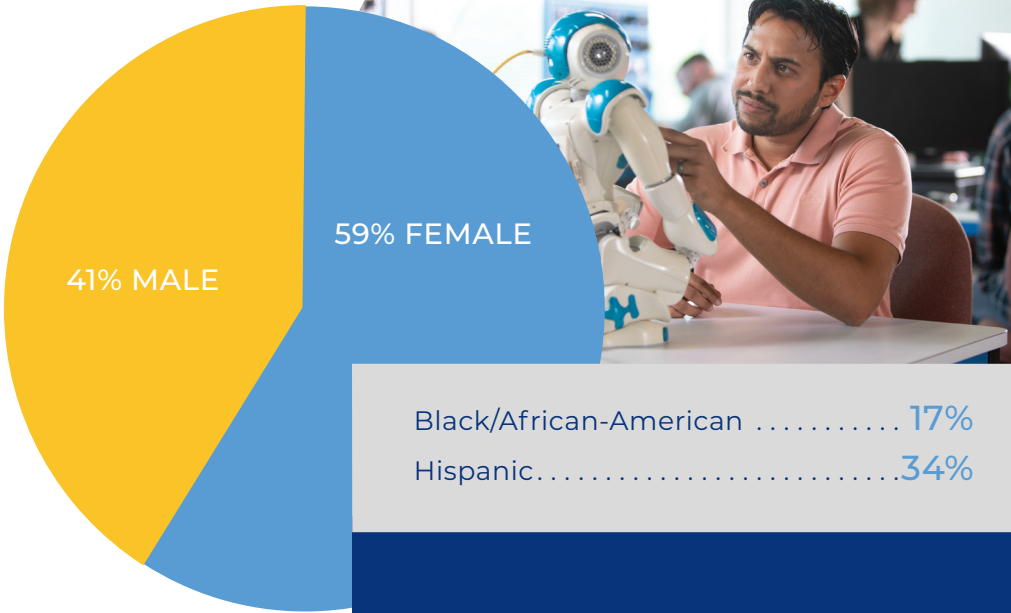


# OUR STUDENTS
